- ➤ Been exposed to anyone currently awaiting Covid-19 test results?



Is your child experiencing any of the following symptoms:

- Fever or chills (100.4 degrees or higher)
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Trouble breathing
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Headache

If NO, GO TO SCHOOL



My child has been exposed to someone with Covid-19 or tested positive for Covid-19:

Your child will not be able to return to school for 14 days after last exposure to a Covid positive individual **and** able to successfully answer the questions on this screener

My child has symptoms listed and has been seen by a Doctor:

A Doctor's note is required clearing the child to return to school *and must* be fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication if fever is present.

My child has symptoms listed and has NOT been seen by a Doctor:

Your child will be excluded for a minimum of 10 days from the onset of symptoms *and* must be fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication if fever is present *and* able to successfully answer the questions on the screener. If your child is not symptom free after 10 days then the recommendation is to see your child's doctor.
